But I can't. I've moved to Delhi and my vote is registered in Assam. Don't have the money to go all the way.

Oh but you don't have to. You do know you can shift your vote?

If you have moved places and your vote is registered elsewhere, shifting your vote is an easy process.

Prepare Your Documents

Gather your current **valid address proof**—

Aadhar card,

TG card

ration card etc.

Get Form Signed from Admin

If you are a college student and live away from home in a **PG, flat, or shared accommodation** in another city,

Download the form

Get it **signed** by your college admin

Online Application

Visit the provided link and fill out **Form 6** in green color to create an account.

Then, fill out **Form 8** in orange color with your Election ID Card Number and verify your details.

Choosing Shifting Option

Select "**shifting of residence**" and specify whether it's within or outside your assembly constituency.



Fill out the Form. If you're a student living away from home, Upload the **scan copy of signed form.**

Block Level Officer will make a House Visit

A Block Level officer will **contact you and visit your house** for verification



Note

Know that you don't need your voter id to cast your vote. As long as your name is on the electoral roll and you have any government Identity Proof, you can Vote even **WITHOUT** a Voter ID.

Click submit, note down your reference number

Your new voter ID should arrive within **50 days**. Remember, you can also use this process to make other changes.
