Hey Behan! Have you registered to vote yet? Elections are around



Nope. Since I am an NRI now, I am not sure if I can vote this year



Oh but you can still cast a vote even if you aren't living in India

If you are a **Non Resident Indian**, here is a step by step process



1

Log-in and Select the Form

a Go to **Google** and type '**Voter Service Portal**'

b Quickly **register** or **log in** to the website .

d Select **Form 6A – the Blue** form. Click on **Fill Form to fill online**

Fill Out the Form

Provide **basic information details** as required in the form and click on **SUBMIT**



Save and note down the **reference number** as you'll need it to **track** your application on the same website.

Block Level Officer will make a House Visit

A Block Level officer will **contact you and Visit your house** for verification



4

Receive New Voter ID:

If located in India, you will be issued an **Elector's Photo Identity Card (EPIC)** by post.



Alternatively, you can **download** a digital version through the **voters' service portal**.

Note

Know that **you don't need your voter id to cast your vote**. As long as your name is on the electoral roll and you have any government Identity Proof, you can Vote even **WITHOUT** a Voter ID.

Check your polling location through the portal. Ensure to show up to vote at the correct time.

Your new voter ID should arrive within **50 days**. You can download the digital copy from the portal.
